Would you believe a comprehensive philosophy book could be intriguing and riveting? Nel Noddings provides thought provoking concepts as she presents the “content of philosophy when it is relevant to problems of education” (p. 2). Chapter headings provide a glimpse of what awaits the reader and include philosophers of the twentieth century, John Dewey, analytic and continental philosophy, critical thinking, epistemology, social science, ethics, social and political philosophy, and feminism. In a little over 200 pages, Nel Noddings provides a comprehensible, concise framework for a very theoretical topic. She uses summary questions at the end of each chapter to synthesize the reader’s understanding and offers an introduction to literature for further interest.
